

ORDINANCE #2018-01 ESTABLISHING HOURS FOR PERMITTED
USE OF THE BLUEBERRY COURT BOAT LAUNCH IN THE TOWN OF
WESCOTT


The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Wescott does ordain as follows:

1. **Authority.** This ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority conferred by Section 30.77 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter NR 1.91 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
2. **Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to establish reasonable hours of operation for the Blueberry Court Boat Launch located in the Town of Wescott to promote the safe use of the facility, as well as to reduce noise for neighboring residents during nighttime and early morning hours.
3. **Establishment of Hours.** The Blueberry Court boat launch shall be closed daily between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. No person shall launch or retrieve a boat or any other watercraft at the Blueberry Court Boat Launch in the Town of Wescott during the hours it is closed.
4. **No Loitering.** No person may congregate, occupy or otherwise loiter in or near the Blueberry Court Boat Launch between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. provided, however, that nothing in this section is intended to prevent the regular flow of traffic or passage of persons down the regularly traveled portions of Blueberry Court. No person may congregate, occupy or otherwise loiter in or near the Blueberry Court Boat Launch during operating hours (6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.) in any way that interferes with the public's use of the boat launch and/or with the regular flow of traffic or passage of persons down the regularly traveled portions of Blueberry Court.
5. **Penalties.** Any person who violates this ordinance shall be issued a citation. The forfeiture associated with a citation for violating this ordinance will be \$50 for the first offense and \$100 for each subsequent offense. If a boat or any other watercraft is involved in a violation of this ordinance, the owner and/or operator shall be liable for the violation. It shall be no defense


to a violation of this ordinance that the owner of the watercraft was not the operator at the time of violation.

6. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provisions of this ordinance or application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
